

# Transnational cooperation in EIP — How it works?

## EIP in the CAP Strategic Plan of Finland 2023-2027

- Total public funding for EIP is **20 million euro**, of which:
- 5 MEUR for national EIP projects;
- 15 MEUR for regional EIP projects.
- Total public funding max. 500 000 €/ project
- Calls for national EIP projects 1-2 times/ year
- Calls for regional EIP projects continuous; selection 4 times/year



## Specific requirements for TNC projects in the Finnish national legislation

- Minimum of 2 partners in a transnational project (Finland + 1)
- Justification why project needs to be transnational in the application (added value).
- Costs for coordination of a transnational cooperation project are eligible.
- On all other aspects, transnational projects follow the same rules and procedures as national projects.
- Earlier experience on transnational Leader projects implemented since the 1990's, as well as FI & EE transnational cooperation in an EIP project during the previous programming period.



#### **Implementation of TNC in practise**

- 1. Joint planning of the project (with joint objectives), taking into account specific requirements and timing of the calls in the participating countries.
- 2. Each project partner has to apply for funding from its own managing authority to implement the joint activities, as CAP strategic plan is not a transnational programme and there is no joint budget.
- 3. After the financial decisions from the MAs, joint implementation of the TNC project, as agreed among project partners on division of tasks.
- A written agreement between the transnational partners is recommended.



#### Role of administrations and networks

- Contacts and cooperation between MAs, PAs and NRNs is very important both in application and implementation phase of a TNC project.
- Information exchange between MAs e.g. about timing and themes
  of the calls, specific requirements for EIP in the national
  legislations, decision-making procedure etc. is essential for
  success of the TNC project.
- National Rural Networks can help project applicants to find information and potential partners from the other member states through their networks.



#### **Summary**

- There are no administrative structures or procedures defined for transnational cooperation projects in the EU legislation for CAP strategic plans.
- Transnational cooperation projects can well be implemented through the existing legislation and procedures of the CAP.
- Each project partner applies for funding from the MA of its own member state and follow the rules of that member state.
- Coordination and cooperation is essential at all levels of administration and project implementation.
