<u>Tools4CAP</u> (*Innovative Toolbox empowering effective CAP governance towards EU ambitions*) is a Horizon Europe coordination and support action (2023-2026) led by Ecorys and involving 20 partner organisations. The project's mission is to support the design and monitoring of the 2023-2027 national CAP Strategic Plans and lay the foundations for a sound preparation of the post 2027 through bottom-up adaptation of innovative methods and tools.

The <u>Academy</u>, coordinated by the European Association for Innovation in Local Development (<u>AEIDL</u>) in collaboration with project partners, offers a tailored training programme aimed at building capacity and fostering peer learning among stakeholders, and it is composed of a series of modules.

The **objectives** of this module are:

- Provide information and examples on advanced data management and monitoring techniques and tools for the CAP Strategic Plans, such as Area Monitoring System, the Policy Monitoring Tool, the Data Aggregation Platform, as well as the Farm Management Information System (FMIS) and the Digital Farm Book.

- Enhance the exchange, learn and interact with project end users, understood as governance bodies as well as EU, national, and local policy-makers.
