[Tools4CAP](#) (*Innovative Toolbox empowering effective CAP governance towards EU ambitions*) is a Horizon Europe coordination and support action (2023-2026) led by Ecorys and involving 20 partner organisations. The project's mission is to support the design and monitoring of the 2023-2027 national CAP Strategic Plans and lay the foundations for a sound preparation of the post 2027 through bottom-up adaptation of innovative methods and tools.

The [Academy](#), coordinated by the European Association for Innovation in Local Development ([AEIDL](#)) in collaboration with project partners, offers a tailored training programme aimed at building capacity and fostering peer learning among stakeholders, and it is composed of a series of modules.
